SEATS FOR YOMIM NORAIM 5785

As we stand at the threshold of Elul, it is time to prepare for the Yomim Noraim.

The recommended method to make seating reservations is to fill out the seating form and pay via credit card online by accessing the secure website <u>https://aigreenspring.com</u> and using one of the links under the Seating menu on the top. Another option now available is to Zelle your payment to <u>treasurer@aigreenspring.com</u>.

For those unable to reserve on line, you may complete the attached reservation form for seating arrangements and mail it back with full payment, either in the form of a check or a credit card payment, as soon as possible. Due to the shul's current financial situation, we will be unable to accept reservations until full payment is received or special arrangements are made. The deadline for receiving seating reservation requests this year will be Sunday, September 29.

Seats

Men will be seated on the main level while women will be seated in the Ezras Nashim balcony and on the main level. Please indicate on the reservation form any seating preferences you may have in addition to any disabilities which affect your request. Also, please indicate on the form if you intend to bring your own floor-standing *shtender*. We will try to accommodate all seating requests, however physical limitations of the Shul setup may make it necessary to revise final seating arrangements. For women selecting upstairs seating, preference for padded chairs will be given to those intending to stay for longer periods of time.

We are taking reservations for guests at the same time that members make their own reservations.

Seating prices for 5785 are increasing from the previous year and are as follows:

For seating purposes, any dependent child who lives with the member family is considered a child. If the child lives at a separate address and is at least eighteen years old, non-member adult rates shall apply. Children away at school are still considered dependents. Girls up to and including age 6 may sit in the men's section. Children under the age of 5 will not be assigned a seat. Parents of children wishing to daven with the kehilla must ensure that proper shul decorum is not compromised in any way.

In order to be entitled to member prices, annual dues for the current year must be paid in full at the time of seating reservations. Annual dues for 2024 are \$400.00 for full membership and \$150.00 for associate membership. Annual dues for 2025 will increase to \$450.00 for full membership.

Extra Tekios

On both days of Rosh Hashana extra tekios will be blown 10 minutes after the completion of Musaf at the shul.
